Apply for the "Overseas Compatriot Identity Certificate for Military Service" at the Overseas Community Affairs Council

Required Documents

- Valid & original Taiwan passport
- Valid & original proof of overseas residence

(foreign passport / permanent resident card / residence visa or permit)

If permanent residence is difficult to obtain

(Japan, Thailand, Malaysia, Vietnam, Philippines):

- → Provide a residence permit showing 4 consecutive years of legal residence.
 - Certificate of entry/exit dates from the National Immigration Agency (NIA)

(Not required if your Overseas Compatriot Identity Endorsement is still valid.)

If applying through a representative:

- Representative's ID
- Applicant-signed original power of attorney (Verification by overseas mission not required.)
- Before Departure: Upload Documents on Exit Document Review Platform

- Valid Taiwan passport
- Valid foreign passport or overseas residence document
- Valid Overseas Compatriot Identity Certificate for Military Service
