

Exit Application Process for Overseas Compatriot Conscription Males

(Currently have or previously had household registration in Taiwan, from Jan. 1 of the year they turn 19 to Dec. 31 of the year they turn 36)

Apply for the "Overseas Compatriot Identity Certificate for Military Service" at the Overseas Community Affairs Council



Processing time: ½ business day

Required Documents

- Valid & original Taiwan passport
- Valid & original proof of overseas residence (foreign passport / permanent resident card / residence visa or permit)

If permanent residence is difficult to obtain

(e.g. Japan, Thailand, Malaysia, Vietnam, Philippines):

→ Provide proof of **4 consecutive years** of lawful residence, where each residence permit (visa) was valid **for more than one year**.

- **Certificate of entry / exit dates from the National Immigration Agency (NIA)** ⚠ If the applicant holds multiple passports, certificates of entry / exit dates for **all passports** must be submitted (Coverage period: Lifetime).

(Not required if your Overseas Compatriot Identity Endorsement is still valid.)

If applying through a representative:

- Representative's ID
- Applicant-signed original power of attorney (Verification by overseas mission is not required.)

Before Departure : Upload Documents on Exit Document Review Platform

Processing time: 2 business days

- Valid Taiwan passport
- Valid foreign passport or overseas residence document
- Valid Overseas Compatriot Identity Certificate for Military Service
- Proof of entering/exiting the overseas residence within **4 months** before entering Taiwan

(passport stamps, entry / exit record, or boarding pass showing name, date, location)
