2020 年僑務委員會海外青年臺灣文化研習營 活動須知

一、 活動內容：以增進海外青年深入瞭解臺灣豐富多元文化與政經發展現況，及促進國內外青年交流為主題之研習活動，為期 14 天。

二、報名須知：

1. 年滿 16 歲足歲至未滿 28 歲（以護照所載年齡為憑），目前居住於海外，身心健康、學行良好，對臺灣文化研習有興趣之僑界青年。
2. 費用：
 - (1) 學員應繳交學費新臺幣 10,000 元整，於報到時繳交承辦單位，中途離團者，不予退費。
 - (2) 學員來回機票、簽證費、個人零用金、在僑居地參加保險之保險費、醫療等費用自行負擔，其在臺灣研習之膳、宿、交通等費用均由僑務委員會支付。
3. 申請人必須準備 1 吋 (2.54cm) 半身照片 2 張、僑居國護照或僑居身分加簽。
4. 如有疾病或重大身心不適症狀（例如心臟病、腦血管疾病、糖尿病、精神病、癲癇症、傳染病、懷孕等）可能影響活動之正常參加者，請勿報名，否則如因此發生事故，應自行負責，與主、承辦單位無涉。
5. 凡已核准回國升學之僑生，不得報名。報名未經核定者不得隨營活動。
6. 曾有吸毒、犯罪前科或其他品行不佳者，不得報名。
7. 學員應於出發前於當地辦妥個人醫療保險，觀摩期間如因疾病就醫治療，應自行負擔醫療費及返回居留地費用，學員及其家長不得向主辦單位（僑務委員會）或承辦單位提出任何要求。

三、活動應遵守事項：

1. 學員於活動期間發生任何意外事故，主辦單位及承辦單位僅就有故意過失部分負責。
2. 學員在活動期間不接受輔導或不遵守規定事項，致發生意外事故應自行負責，主、承辦單位除有重大過失外，對該學（職）員不負任何賠償責任，如有任何爭議皆依中華民國法律處理。
3. 請學員切實遵守中華民國海關規定，辦理行李通關手續，不得攜帶任何違禁品及保育類動物製品。
4. 請學員攜帶正式服裝（男性備襯衫及領帶、女性備裙裝）、輕便夾克及球鞋等，以應各種場合穿著。
5. 請學員依活動規定日期抵臺及離臺，如因機位等因素必須提早或延後，停留期間一切費用自理。研習活動行程結束後，學員應即返回僑居地，不得以任何理由，或以僑生、留學生身分留臺升學或居留。
6. 如因學員之違法行為或其它可歸責於學員之事由，致遭政府機關羈押或留置時，應由該學員自行負責，與主、承辦單位無涉，並應負責賠償本活動主、承辦單位因此所受之一切損害。
7. 學員須全程參加活動，不得私自離營，若有特殊情形必須提前離營者，應由家長出具申請書說明原因，由駐外館處或華僑文教服務中心轉送僑務委員會核准後，通知承辦單位依程序辦妥離營手續後方可離營，學員離營後之行為，由學員及家長自行負責，與主承辦單位無涉。
8. 學員於活動期間不接受輔導或不遵守規定事項，情節重大者，經查證屬實，僑務委員會得逕予退訓處理，學員及家長不得異議，並不予退費。

Guidelines for 2020 Compatriot Youth Taiwan Culture Study Program

1. Objective: The OCAC will hold this program to give overseas (compatriot) youth an understanding of Taiwan's diverse culture and its political and economic development situation and to promote exchange between domestic and overseas youth. This Program will last 14 days.
2. Qualifications for Registration:
 - (1) Must be overseas compatriot youth 16-28 years of age (based on age specified in the passport); must reside abroad; must be in good health, physically and mentally; and must be in good standing in terms of academic performance and conduct, and interested in learning about Taiwanese culture.
 - (2) Expenses:
 - a. Registration fee: NT\$10,000 per person, to be paid to the host unit at the time of check-in. There will be no refund to those who leave the program early.
 - b. Participants are responsible for their own round-trip airfare to and from Taipei, visa fee, medical and travel insurance premiums, and personal expenses. However, the OCAC, Republic of China (Taiwan) will provide accommodations, meals, and transportation within Taiwan.
 - (3) The applicants are required to submit 2 original passport-style pictures (1 inch or 2.54cm), a valid passport to Taiwan.
 - (4) Each applicant must be in good health (free of heart problems, cardio-vascular illness, diabetes, mental disorder, epilepsy, infectious disease, pregnancy and others that may cause serious symptoms) in order to participate in the Program. Otherwise, participants are responsible for any accident occurred.
 - (5) Students who already have the approval from the government agency to study in Taiwan will not be allowed to attend this Program. All applicants must receive approval from OCAC, otherwise the applicants will not be accepted to the Program.
 - (6) Applicants who have criminal records or drug abuse problems will not be allowed to attend.
 - (8) Participants should buy medical insurance before leaving for Taiwan. If participants are sick and have to stay in the hospital during the Program, they will have to pay their own medical and return expenses. Requests by parents for medical compensations from the OCAC and undertaking agency will not be accepted.
3. Rules and Regulations:
 - (1) Program sponsors are not responsible for any accidents during the period of program except for any incident occurring as a result of negligence caused by program activities.
 - (2) Participants are responsible for any accident caused by not following the advice, rules and regulations. The sponsors will not be held financially liable for any incidents except for the occurrence of significant negligence on the part of the Program organizers. If any dispute occurs, the laws of Taiwan will prevail.
 - (3) Follow the rules and regulations of the Customs; customs clearance formalities must be completed for luggage; contraband articles and endangered species products are prohibited.
 - (4) Please bring semi-formal attire (tie, shirt, and slacks for males, skirt and blouse for females,) casual clothes, light jacket and sneakers to meet the needs of different activities.
 - (5) All the participants must set their arrival and departure dates according to the Program schedule. No changes will be allowed. For any changes in these schedules, Program participants are responsible for all additional expenses. After the Program ends, participants must return to their resident countries within the scheduled visa stay period and

must not stay in Taiwan for any reason including for higher education as an overseas compatriot student or overseas student.

(6) Any infractions of Taiwan's laws or evidence of contribution to such resulting in punitive actions by the R.O.C. government or law enforcement officials towards a program participant will be left to that individual own responsibility. The program organizers will not be held responsible for any such actions. Consequently, the program sponsors may also request compensations for any inconveniences caused by this individual or situation.

(7) All participants must attend the whole program according to the program schedule. No changes will be allowed. If early departure from the Program is required due to certain special situations, participants' parents must submit an application (with the explanation of the reason) via an overseas ROC mission/office or Overseas Compatriot Chinese Language and Culture Center, receive approval from OCAC and then wait until program-departure formalities have been completed by the undertaking unit before leaving the Program. The behavior of participants after leaving the Program will be his/her and his/her parents' responsibility and will not involve the organizing or undertaking unit.

(8) All applicants must follow the group regulations and guidance. For serious circumstances, under the true investigation from OCAC, the applicants will be withdrawn from the Program, and the objection from applicants and parents will not be accepted, and applicants must pay all of related fees for joining this program in future.
