Hurricane Dorian to Make Landfall on Florida Coast

Hurricane Dorian is expected to approach the Florida Coast on or about September 1, 2019, as at least a category 4 (130-156 mph winds) hurricane. Heavy rain, flooding, strong storm surge, and hurricane force winds will be a threat to much of the Florida Peninsula on September 1st and 2nd. Foreign Missions are encouraged to monitor and follow state and local authorities as well as FEMA during this hurricane.

Foreign Missions should begin making necessary arrangements for staff in the affected region and to have up to date contact information to reach them prior, during, and following the storm.
